

# Aunt Naomi's Redwork Quilt

## Fabric:

- 1 1/2 yd. backing
- Fabrics (must be 100% cotton): Cutting measurements are included if you want to pre-cut your fabric. When we say "strips" we refer to 42"-44" wide fabric. (For instance if instructions say cut a 1 1/2 " strip that means 1 " X the width of the fabric or 42".)
- Solid white (or reads as a solid) 1 yd. (Cut nine 9 1/2 " blocks)
- Red Sashing: Cut three 2" strips
- Red Border #1: Cut four 2" strips
- White Border #2: 1/3 yd (Cut four 2 1/2 " strips)
- Red Border #3: 1/2 yd (Cut four 3 1/2 " strips)

## Embroidery:

- For this Project use Sulky Cotton 30 WT thread in needle, regular sewing thread (red) in bobbin.
- Hoop up stabilizer only (4X4 inch hoop)
- Fold the white block to find the center of block, find and mark center of the hoop. Use glue stick or spray adhesive on stabilizer, hoop up and embroider according to your machine's instructions. Remove stabilizer.
- Size block to 9", Press lightly.

## Decorative Stitches:

On the Designer SE choose E Menu (Quilting) Select Stitch # 62(OR: Choose any decorative stitch you wish). Lightly press the border fabric down the center- this will give you a guideline for stitching the decorative stitch. Use a light stabilizer underneath (Stitch-and-Ditch)- Stitch

## Piecing:

Sew 2" sashing to the RIGHT side of six of the blocks

Press seams toward dark

Add remaining blocks- keeping sashing on the inside- creating a 3X3 block layout.(See cutting layout page) Press.

Add border 1 (1 1/2" strips), 2 (2"), and 3 (3")

Quilt as Desired
