Fabric list: Background: 3/4 yard Outside Triangles: 1 yard Pink sashing: 1/4 yard 2 Solid and 6 Floral fabric for Applique – 1 Fat Quarter Each Quilt Back – 1 yard Binding-- 1 Fat Quarter


Elmer's Washable School Glue Sticks Tear and Wash Stabilizer (Brands include Inspira, avaliable at Viking and Pfaff dealers, HTC Rinse-away available online, Floriani Stitch N Wash) Cuticle Sticks



Cutting instructions for the corner blocks and sashing applique. Sashing: Washable stabilizer cut $12 - 9 \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips

Fabric- Cut $3 - 1 \frac{12}{2}$ strips to glue stabilizer to Corner blocks: Washable stabilizer cut 9- 2" squares Fabric - Cut $9 - 2 \frac{12}{2}$ squares

Follow instructions on the video for applique prep and sewing.



34 ½ x 34 ½"



A- Cut two 18" squares Cut on diagonal

B- Cut one 24 ¾" square

Sew the triangles, opposing sides, to the square, matching raw edges. Press. Your quilt top is done! Check out the machine binding video on tensisters.com.



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
